Every year the Foundation holds a Spring Fundraiser to help raise funds for the school. This year's Spring Fundraiser features the familiar fun of a pinewood derby combined with raising money for quality Christian education at Faith Christian School!

Students will each build and race a car in the event. Students in preschool through 8th grade, will build a car from pinewood kits. Students will receive pre-cut cars and have the option to work at home or at specified work-days. We will schedule two **Saturday working sessions (April 15th & April 22nd)** for students to get assistance with sanding, painting, weighting and assembling of their cars. Work on cars will begin in late March.

Race day is scheduled for Saturday, April 29th at 1:00 pm. Students will also build a team of race sponsors who donate to support their car and school. We are planning to broadcast the event on Facebook live for those who may want to see the event but live a distance away.



We are still in need of a few volunteers on the work days to assist kids in building their cars, and also on the race day to help with a variety of tasks. If you would be interested in helping with either of these times, please contact us at the email address or phone number below.

Money from race sponsors will be used to help lower the cost of tuition, making an education at Faith more accessible. Faith Christian School Foundation provides funding that is the equivalent of about \$2,500 per student each year, through fundraisers like this.

We have also received matching gifts from a few of our major donors to double the impact of gifts given to this event. The first \$300 raised by each racer will be matched up to the limit of the fund. It would be great if every racer were able to meet this challenge!


Racing Team Instructions

Every racer needs a strong supporting team! In the Faith Derby, racers are asked to form a racing team and recruit race sponsors to support their cause. If there are multiple students in your family, you can choose to register each one separately or register a single family team.

To begin creating your team, scan the code to the right and go to the main derby page. You can also go to www.fcskearney.org/derby and click on the button “Register”.




Next, you will get a page to create your team and customize your page. You need to give your team a name and edit any other information you like. If you choose to accept the defaults here, you can always change the information later. We recommend

setting a goal of at least \$300 which is the amount of our match for each racer, but you can also set a higher goal.




